BYOD Models

BYOD - Bring Your Own Device

BYOX

- Bring Your Own Anything
- Can include phones, Ipads, Tablets and laptops
- Not a viable option for FCAC

CYOD

- School provides several options
- Families choose, pay school and school places bulk order

BYOD

- School provides minimum specs
- Families make their own private purchase

FCAC BYOD

- Continuation of 2019 rollout to Year 7 and 10 students
- Parent option to partner with supplier – Eg JB Hifi, Capsicum
- Not limited to these suppliers
- JB-Hifi Portal access provided for parents

FCAC BYOD

- College has shortlisted suggested models across a range of suppliers that meet recommended specifications
- Options for extended warranty and accidental damage provided by supplier
- Pool of school owned devices for student access as required





What about the College's Duty of Care?

- As with the College's existing 1:1 device program, students accessing resources using BYOD will be protected by the default filtering policy provided by CyberHound.
- No laptop install is required for the filtering policy to apply while onsite.

What about offsite?

- As BYOD devices are owned by parents, this filtering policy does not apply when the devices are offsite
- Parents are able to monitor and moderate use through a variety of methods:
 - Microsoft Family accounts (free)
 - Use of specific hardware – eg Disney Circle
 - Use of specific software (eg Familyzone, Qustodio)
- Support available if required

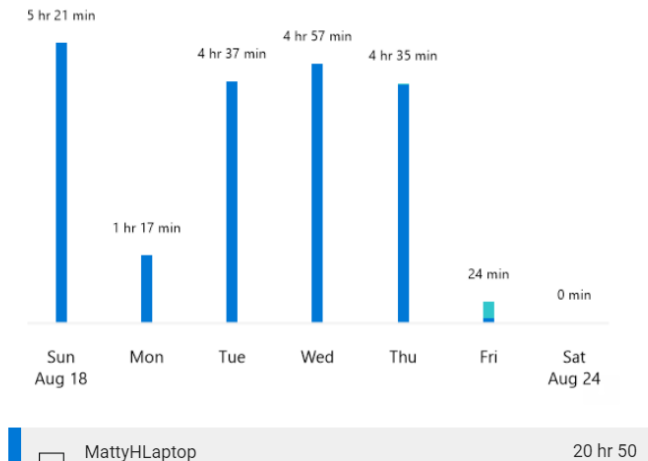

Parental controls

Parental controls are available for most devices, either through pre-installed settings that can be activated yourself on a device, or via the installation of free or commercial software.

Search safely

We all use search engines to find information online, and so do our kids.

Recommended Specification

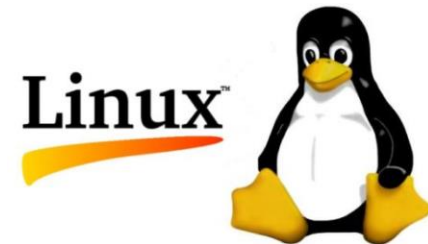
- Intel Core i5 processor or equivalent
- 8 gigabytes of RAM
- 256 SSD
- Dual band (AC) wireless
- ** Battery that will last the school day **
- 3 Year warranty
- Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) for the life of the device
- A dedicated bag for the device



Alternatives to Windows laptops



- FCAC is a Windows/PC based environment
- Devices running MacOS – eg MacBook Pro and MacBook Air devices - can be used if parents make this choice.
- iPad and iPad Pro devices running iOS are not considered laptop replacements. This also applies to Android tablets and (at this stage) Google Chromebooks. Linux software is also not supported.
- Non-Windows devices must have the ability to either dual boot Windows or use Windows in a virtualized environment. Eg – using Parallels on Apple laptops to run Windows.





Provision of Software




- Microsoft Office is the mandated default Word Processing/ Productivity application for BYOD. This is available to all students for free as part of the Office365 subscription and is accessible using their College email addresses.
- Specific software will be provided to students as required – eg Autodesk Sketchup/AutoCad.
- Use of Anti-Virus software is at the discretion of parents. Numerous free options available - Windows Defender, Avast, AVG etc




