Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We have been monitoring the situation over the past 24 hours and can provide you with the following update:

- The Easter Hat Parade scheduled for tomorrow will be cancelled.
- Cross Country will be postponed and altered. It will become an optional event for Secondary students, run at a designated lunch time in Week 1 of Term 2. Primary students will complete the course as part of their HPE lessons in Term 2. Age Champions will be awarded but there will be no overall House winner.
- Foundation Day Assembly and activities will regrettably be cancelled for the second year running. Elements of this day will be included in the ANZAC Day / Grandparents Day activities on 23 April, where appropriate. We will try and have some low key celebrations this Thursday.
- Based on updated advice from the Department of Education, we are able to have more teachers return to work from tomorrow. Lessons will be able to continue as per normal.

The decisions to cancel or postpone events were not made lightly and are designed to restrict the amount of movement in, out and around the College.

Thank you to those who have contacted us with queries. Where we do not have the answer readily at hand for you, we seek advice from the relevant authorities before replying. If the situation changes, we will provide another update.
