### A description of how non-attendance is managed by the school:

If a child is unable to attend school, parents are required to inform the College, prior to 8.30am each day, of their child's absence. Parents can use a dedicated email address or the College app to report absences. If the College does not receive notification on the morning of an absence an SMS message is sent to the parents designated mobile phone number.

Accurate student records regarding attendance are recorded on the College's data base. The Student Services team are responsible for collating attendance data.
